Things will be "ramping up" as we get closer to our Fall Festival season. I know, we're not even at summer yet, but, it's never too early to plan and put the plan in place! That being said, we will be attending the Maple Park Fun Fest to be held on Saturday, September1 and the Sycamore Pumpkin Festival to be held in October. I will look for one more autumn festival as well. I will be looking for volunteers for the Pumpkin Festival and an additional an additional autumn festival and will pass around a sign up sheet as things get closer. I'll take care of the Maple Park Festival but if anyone would like to come keep e company, I'd be happy to have you with.

We have 3 18" dolls which are left from the last quilt show. I would like to use these dolls at our autumn festivals for raffles and am looking for members to step up and sew "ensembles" for these dolls. They are 18" in height and I am told there are NUMEROUS patterns on the internet and in pattern books. Please sign up at the check in table at our next meeting to make these outfits, dolls quilts, accessories for these dolls or all of the above! We want to offer up these "babies" in order to help bring more funds to the guild. I'll check the internet for patterns and bring copies of what I find to the next meeting as well.

I have some ideas for items that we can sell at the upcoming fests and will show a sample to you at the next meeting. One of the items is called a "Bottle Buddy" which is a little felt bag that hangs on a wine bottle and can hold all kinds of goodies inside. (You can use it for a beer bottle, apple cider etc.) Pair the liquid contents of the bottle with a tasty treat: wine and chocolate or perhaps apple cider with candy corn? You get the idea. The other idea I have is a "Market Bag" which folds inside itself-making it great to take to the grocery store, farmers market, or wherever you may find you need some help carrying your items. I'll bring a sample of this also.

Rather than having a bunch of different items at these shows, I would like to try having just a few items-maybe 4-5 items— with "inventory" of each so, please feel free to bring some ideas to fill up our tables. Soooo, what e need to do is to arrange a sewing day or 2 to work on these items-Rosalee? Can you help us out with your church? We would be looking at perhaps 2 dates-one in mid July and one in mid August.

Last but not least, I want to put together a "picture board" showcasing what our guild does with photos and narratives so I will have my camera at the ready at the next few meetings to capture some "action" shots.

So, to sum it up-we will be attending at least 2 craft shows this fall beginning September 1. We will sell 4-5 items and raffle 3 18" dolls complete with a few outfits and a doll quilt, we need to set up a couple of sewing days and a picture board will be on display.
