# **WAYS AND MEANS**

From Kathi Davis – Thanks to all the members that have contributed to the raffle quilt. We now have completed over half the blocks we need! When going through the blocks at the Sewing Saturday March 8<sup>th</sup>, we determined that there were so many that were good at 12 ½ without modifications or minimal ones, it was more efficient to make all the blocks that size



rather than the 12 ½ in the pattern. We, also, have received more than enough blocks to finish the quilt. The ones left need to be squared to 12 ¼ inches with all the points ¼ inch from the edge of the block.

So, we will be working on the rest of the blocks at the next Sewing Saturday, April 12<sup>th</sup>. Also, the sashing needs to be completed with the batik squares. And before the final assembly, a big challenge—the placement of the blocks in the final quilt! I'm looking for a mobile "design wall" big enough (96" X 104")

to use at the church. Any suggestions??? Please let me know. We do have the quilt rack we use to hang a raffle quilt. I'm thinking we might be able to use that with some flannel.
